



House of Ölvestad Guidelines for Philanthropic Partnerships

I. Purpose & Ethos

Philanthropy is a central pillar of House of Ölvestad. It is understood not as an expression of prestige, but as a responsibility grounded in continuity, stewardship, and tangible impact.

These Guidelines define the principles under which House of Ölvestad engages in philanthropic partnerships, ensuring that all such engagements are conducted with integrity, seriousness, and long-term perspective.

II. Nature of Philanthropic Partnerships

A philanthropic partnership with House of Ölvestad is a substantive collaboration based on shared values, clearly defined purpose, and responsible execution.

Such partnerships are distinct from sponsorship arrangements, honorary associations, or symbolic affiliations lacking practical substance.

III. Selection Criteria

Before any philanthropic partnership is considered, transparency in governance and use of resources, local grounding, demonstrable impact, ethical alignment, and long-term seriousness must be present.

No partnership is entered into solely on the basis of reputation, social standing, or personal connection.

IV. Independence, Process & Integrity

House of Övestad approaches philanthropy with independence of judgement and respect for established institutional processes.

Philanthropic engagement is entered into on its own merits, guided by purpose, trust, and long-term responsibility. Any form of recognition, distinction, or honour that may follow charitable engagement is understood to arise from independent institutional evaluation, according to the statutes, practices, and requirements of the conferring body.

Where contributions, participation fees, or administrative costs form part of an established and transparent framework, such arrangements are understood as structural and procedural, not transactional in nature.

Philanthropy is undertaken in good faith, with openness to recognition where it may arise, and without presumption or entitlement.

V. Representation & Visibility

Visibility in philanthropic partnerships is secondary to impact. Where appropriate, House of Övestad may be acknowledged discreetly and with restraint.

Visibility is never demanded, exaggerated, or used as a condition for philanthropic engagement.

VI. Duration, Review & Accountability

Philanthropic partnerships are not presumed to be permanent. All partnerships are subject to periodic review and may be respectfully concluded if objectives or standards are no longer met.

VII. Courtesy & Conduct

House of Övestad approaches all philanthropic engagement with respect, cultural sensitivity, and good faith. Concerns are addressed privately, proportionately, and constructively.

VIII. Closing Statement

Philanthropy, when undertaken responsibly, is an act of continuity. House of Övestad engages in charitable partnerships with restraint, clarity, and long-term responsibility, in service of real impact, human dignity, and future generations.
